

Who Are You?

You are a JOINT-HEIR with Christ

If children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together. Romans 8:17

The benefits of being a joint-heir -- Jesus:

• Came to share <u>eternal</u> life with you.

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

• **Overcame** the world for you.

You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. 1 John 4:4

You have an <u>inheritance</u>

It is irrevocable – It cannot be changed.

Then the King will say to those on His right, `Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. Matthew 25:34

• Empowers you with His <u>name</u>.

And I will do whatever you ask in My name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it. John 14:13-14

• Intercedes for <u>you</u> with the Father.

I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those You have given Me, for they are Yours.

John 17:9

• <u>**Rescues**</u> you from evil.

... the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father. Galatians 1:4
